For filming and photography, we have a number of underground carriages available that include the Victoria Line (1967-2011) tube carriage with driver's cabin access, a 1950s-present day Metropolitan line train and a beautifully refurbished 1938 stock with art deco inspired interior. The carriages are excellent for internal and external filming along with a number of buses that include original posters and advertisements. Crews have access to green room facilities, as well as free onsite parking and a dedicated onsite supervisor. Onsite power is available where possible.
